ORDINANCE NO. 978

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LOUISVILLE, NEBRASKA TO ESTABLISH FEES FOR CITY SERVICES; TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT; TO PROVIDE FOR PUBLICATION IN PAMPHLET FORM; AND TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOUISVILLE, NEBRASKA:

Section 1: The City Council of the City of Louisville has determined that the fee structure for services and products provided by the City shall be revised as follows:

5. The fee for new water service connection within the City corporate limits is \$0.00, plus the costs of material and labor. The fee for new water service connection outside the City corporate limits is \$825.00, plus the costs of material and labor. Applications for each new service connection must be accompanied by payment of the applicable connection fee and material costs. The City shall disconnect any water service if material and labor costs are not paid within thirty (30) days.

- 6. Late Fee on Accounts Remaining Unpaid Fifteen (15) days after billing date: 10%.
- 7. Property owner's responsibility starts at the curb stop and continues to house. It is the owner's responsibility to maintain and bear all liability of damages caused by leaking. Meter must be purchased and installed through the City.

(a) Residential	\$34.50 for zero gallons plus \$3.50 for every 1,000 gallons, based on average water usage for January, February and March or on 4500 gallons until an average has been established for the household.
(b) Commercial	\$37.87 for zero gallons plus \$3.75 for every 1,000 gallons,
	based on the previous calendar year's average water usage.
(c) Industrial	\$71.62 for zero gallons plus \$7.50 for every 1,000 gallons,
	based on the previous calendar year's average water usage.

3. The fee for new sewer service connection within the City corporate limits is \$0.00, plus the costs of material and labor. The fee for new sewer service connection outside the City

corporate limits is \$825.00, plus the costs of material and labor. Applications for each new service connection must be accompanied by payment of the applicable connection fee and material costs. The City shall disconnect any sewer service if material and labor costs are not paid within thirty (30) days.
